Excerpt from An Account of the College of Physicians of Philadelphia But the first meeting after its full organization, at which nine senior and four junior Fellows were present, did not take place until January 2, 1787, and this day, therefore, by common consent, is regarded as its official birthday. The minutes of this meeting record that the officers of the College were: President, John Redman; vicepresident, John Jones; treasurer, Gerardus Clarkson; secretary, James Hutchinson; censors, William Shippen, Jr., Benjamin Rush, John Morgan, and Adam Kuhn. A fair copy of the constitution was signed by the members present, and the publication of this constitution in the Pennsylvania Packet and Daily Advertiser, February 1, 1787, was authorized. One month later, at the stated meeting of the College, the secretary reported that the constitution had been published as directed. A device for a seal was submitted and, slightly modified, was adopted so as to read non sibi sed toti. The seal was ordered to be cut with this legend: Sigillum Collegii Medicorum, Philadelphia Institut., A. D., MDCCLXXXVII. Objects and...
